



NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF A  
REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL FOR PREPARATION OF  
THIRD-PARTY ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT FOR THE  
**PERMIAN GLOBAL ACCESS PIPELINE PROJECT**

*July 17, 2019* - Permian Global Access Pipeline LLC (PGAP) proposes to construct, own and operate an approximate 625-mile long, 42-inch diameter interstate natural gas pipeline in Texas and Louisiana. PGAP is soliciting proposals for the consultation and coordination of the development of an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) and alternatives, early identification and resolution of issues, and preparation of related documents to address the proposed PGAP Project. The EIS will be prepared under a third-party contractor arrangement with PGAP as the Applicant and the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission as the lead federal agency for the National Environmental Policy Act process.
